certified black angus sirloin, imported lobster tails, shrimp, scallops, and more on tabletop grills. **Olive Garden**, one of Ho‘okipa Terrace’s newest restaurants and a first to Hawai‘i, features comforting dishes prepared with fresh ingredients that are uniquely and traditionally Italian.

### **FAST CASUAL RESTAURANTS**

For a quick bite to eat, head to the Makai Market Food Court, Lānai @ Ala Moana Center, or any one of the Center’s many casual dining vendors for everything from sandwiches, salads and sushi to Thai or Chinese takeout.

Located at Lānai @ Ala Moana Center, local favorites like **Ahi & Vegetable** features high-quality tuna chosen daily from Honolulu’s fish auction, while **Mahaloha Burger**’s locally inspired menu features 100 percent free-range beef straight from Hawai‘i Island. Or wind down at **Agave & Vine**, an agave bar where shoppers can indulge in an impressive selection of excellent tequilas, wines and craft beers.
